

IMPLEMENTS OF HUSBANDRY (IoH) AGRICULTURAL COMMERCIAL VEHICLES (Ag CMV)

Please Take Note:

*Per WI State Statute 86.02, **Injury to highway.** Any person who shall injure any highway by obstructing or diverting any creek or watercourse or sluiceway, or by dragging logs or timber thereon, **or by any other act, shall be liable in treble damages**, to be recovered by the political division chargeable with the maintenance of highway injured, and the amount recovered shall be credited to the highway maintenance fund.*

- Complete the appropriate No-Fee Permit Application from the WI Department of Transportation as it pertains to your type of equipment:

MV2582	-	No Fee Permit Application for IoH
		Or
MV2583	-	No Fee Permit Application for Ag CMV

- Once application is made to the Roads Manager, it may take up to 3 weeks for approval or denial of the permit
- Approved permits will be good for one year but can be renewed annually after the first year of submission for subsequent calendar years
- If you obtain a new piece of equipment during the year, you may request an amendment to your current application by contacting the Roads Manager
- Once amendment request is submitted to the Roads Manager it may take up to five days for approval or denial
