

ORDINANCE NO. 10

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING GENERAL PENALTIES

The Town Board of the Town of Oakland, Jefferson County, Wisconsin, DO ORDAIN as follows:

Section 1 General Penalties:

Except as otherwise provided, any person who shall violate any of the provisions of the ordinances of the Town of Oakland shall, upon conviction of such violation, be subject to a penalty, which shall be as follows:

(a) First offense. Any person who shall violate any provision of the ordinances of the Town of Oakland shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than \$5 nor more than \$500, together with the costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs of prosecution may be imprisoned in the County Jail until such forfeiture and costs are paid, but not exceeding 90 days.

(b) Second offense. Any person found guilty of violating any ordinance or part of an ordinance of the Town of Oakland who has previously been convicted of a violation of the same ordinance within one year shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than \$10 nor more than \$500 for each such offense, together with the costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs may be imprisoned in the County Jail until such forfeiture and costs are paid, but not exceeding 6 months.

Section 2 Effective Date.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication and/or posting.
