

ORDINANCE NO. 31

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE UNDERAGE DRINKING IN THE TOWN OF OAKLAND

The Town Board of the Town of Oakland, Jefferson County, Wisconsin, DO ORDAIN as follows:

Ordinance No. 31 of the Town of Oakland is hereby created to read as follows:

UNDERAGE DRINKING

1. STATUTES PERTAINING TO UNDERAGE ALCOHOL VIOLATIONS ADOPTED.

Except as otherwise specifically provided in this ordinance or any other ordinance of the Town of Oakland, statutory provisions of sections 125.07(1),(3), and (4), 125.08(3)(b), and 125.09(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes describing and defining regulations with respect to underage alcohol violations, inclusive of any provisions therein relating to penalties to be imposed but exclusive of any regulations for which the statutory penalty is a fine or term of imprisonment, are hereby adopted and by reference made a part of this ordinance as if fully set forth herein. Any act required to be performed or prohibited by any statute incorporated herein by reference is required or prohibited by this ordinance. Any future amendments, revisions or modifications of the statutes incorporated herein are intended to be made a part of this ordinance.

2. PENALTIES. The penalties for violations of section 1 of this ordinance adopting by reference sections 125.07(1),(3), and (4), 125.08(3)(b), and 125.09(2), Wis. Stats., shall conform to the penalties for violations of the comparable state offenses including any variations or increases for second offenses.

3. REFERENCE TO STATUTES. References to specific statutory sections wherever used in this ordinance shall mean Wisconsin Statutes of 1985-1986 or as subsequently revised.

4. SEVERABILITY. The provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town Board of the Town of Oakland would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provision may be declared invalid and if any provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication and/or posting.
