

ORDINANCE NO. 32

AN ORDINANCE IN REGULATION OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES

The Town Board of the Town of Oakland, Jefferson County, Wisconsin, DO ORDAIN as follows:

Section 1 Definitions:

For purposes of this section, the definition of an "all-terrain vehicle" and all other definitions set forth in sec. 23.33(1), Wis. Stats., as now stated and hereafter amended, are adopted hereby and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2 Adoption of State Statutes:

The provisions of secs. 23.33(2), (3), (4), (5), (6), and (7), Wis. Stats., are incorporated herein by reference as the same exist as of the adoption of this ordinance, or as the same be amended from time to time. These provisions relate to the registration, rules of operation, age restrictions, and equipment requirements for all-terrain vehicles as set forth in Chapter 23, Wis. Stats.

Section 3 Penalties:

Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be subject to a forfeiture of not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200) per violation together with costs, penalties and assessments as may be imposed by the municipal court.

Section 4 Effective Date.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication and/or posting.
