

ORDINANCE NO. 48

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF
PROVISIONAL RETAIL LICENSES

The Town Board of the Town of Oakland, Jefferson County, Wisconsin, DO
ORDAIN as follows:

Ordinance No. 48 shall be created to read as follows:

1. Pursuant to the authorization granted to municipalities by sec. 125.185, Wis. Stats., the Town Clerk of the Town of Oakland shall hereafter be authorized to issue provisional retail licenses without prior approval of the Town Board of the Town of Oakland.

2. Such licenses shall be issued only by the Town Clerk and only to a person who has applied for a Class "A", Class "B", "Class A", "Class B" or "Class C" license. Such provisional license shall authorize only the activities that the type of retail license applied for authorizes.

3. Any applicant for a provisional retail license shall pay a fee of \$15.00. Such fee shall be for the sole purpose of applying for the provisional retail license and no amount shall be applied to the separate fee for applying for a retail license.

4. A provisional retail license shall expire 60 days after its issuance or when the Class "A", Class "B", "Class A", "Class B" or "Class C" license is issued to the holder, whichever is sooner. The Town Clerk may revoke the license if he or she discovers that the holder of the license made a false statement on the application.

5. The Town Clerk may not issue a provisional "Class B" license if the municipality's quota under sec. 125.51(4) Wis. Stats. prohibits the municipality from issuing a "Class B" license.

6. No person may hold more than one provisional retail license for each type of license applied for by the holder per year.

7. No license shall be issued to anyone who has previously been denied a retail license.

The Town Board DO FURTHER ORDAIN that this Ordinance shall be effective following its adoption and publication.
