

ORDINANCE NO. 8

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AND REENACT ORDINANCE NO. 8 REGARDING THE REGULATION OF THE HOURS FOR THE OPERATION OF BUSINESSES SELLING AND DISPENSING ALCOHOL BEVERAGES IN THE TOWN OF OAKLAND.

The Town Board of the Town of Oakland, Jefferson County, Wisconsin, DO ORDAIN as follows:

Ordinance No. 8 of the Town of Oakland is hereby repealed and reenacted as follows:

SECTION 1. ADOPTION OF PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 125, WIS. STATS.

The provisions of Chapter 125 of the Wisconsin Statutes, relating to the sale of intoxicating liquors, are hereby adopted as a portion of this ordinance and incorporated hereby by reference so far as applicable except as otherwise lawfully provided by Town Ordinance.

SECTION 2. CLOSING HOURS OF BUSINESSES SELLING OR DISPENSING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

A. No premises for which a Class "B" license or permit has been issued may remain open between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. except as otherwise provided in this section. On Saturday and Sunday, the closing hours shall be between 2:30 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.

B. On January 1, premises operating under a Class "B" license or permit are not required to close.

C. No person may sell intoxicating liquor on Class "B" licensed premises in an original unopened package, container or bottle or for consumption away from the premises between 12:00 midnight and 8:00 a.m.

D. Hotels and restaurants whose principal business is the furnishing of food, drinks or lodging to patrons, bowling alleys, curling clubs and golf courses may remain open for the conduct of their regular business but may not sell intoxicating liquor or fermented malt beverages during the closing hours mentioned in this section.

E. In all other respects, the hours set forth in Chapter 125 of the Wisconsin Statutes shall remain in effect.

SECTION 3. PENALTY.

Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$500 and his license shall be subject to review for suspension or revocation.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication and/or posting.
